FBC Youth had a great time at Mission Madness in Athens, GA, last month. They learned how we are called to be salt and light, and use the gifts God has given us. They also helped organize books for Books for Keeps and cleaned a kitchen for Our Daily Bread.

#### From One Minister to Another...

Our youth recently had a weekend retreat where they went to Athens, GA, to participate in Mission Madness. Mission Madness is where students go to dedicate a weekend to service. A church (big thanks to First Baptist Athens and Milledge Avenue Baptist) will host and students will go out into the community and serve. We arrived Friday night for worship, where we looked at Matthew 5:13, talking about how we are called to be the salt of the earth. The worship service helped encourage us for our day of service ahead.

Saturday morning we broke up into our service groups. Half of our group went to Books for Keeps and the other half went to Our Daily Bread. At Books for Keeps, we helped sort books into different categories such as children's chapter books, children's picture books, adult fiction, adult non-fiction, etc. The books we sorted were to be given out free of charge. Majority of their work is to get books to children to encourage literacy and learning. At our Daily Bread, students helped clean the kitchen they use to serve meals.

That afternoon we gathered together to pack meals for Rise Against Hunger. The meal would include rice, dried vegetables, protein, and a vitamin pack. These meals go all around the world to people who are experiencing hunger. We were able to pack over 20,000 meals in just a couple of hours. We also did a poverty simulation where students were given a life scenario and they had to figure out how they were going to afford necessities. They experienced the frustration of paying rent, insurance, transportation, and other unexpected costs. Afterward, we were able to rest before dinner and worship. At worship that night we looked at Matthew 5:14-16, and talked about how we can be the light of the world. That evening we had a party with games and snow cones.

Sunday morning we went to worship where we had communion, and were reminded that our service does not stop here. We traveled back home and got some much needed rest. It was great to see our students serving, worshiping, and having fun and making friends along the way. We are grateful for CBF Georgia for putting on this event, and we are grateful for our church for supporting the youth so we are able to go on great trips like this!
