Update from the Transition Team



A letter from the Transition Team, summarizing the results and key insights from the Congregational Conversations, was mailed to the church family on Wednesday. Please take time to read it. It shares valuable information.

As was announced in worship last Sunday, the Transition Team still needs further input in clarifying a few issues before they complete the Church Profile that will be so instrumental to the Pastor Search Team as they seek a prospective Pastor. To aid in this process, they have asked Dr. Travis Collins,

Senior Pastor of FBC of Huntsville, Alabama to lead a weekend workshop sharing insights from his church's journey in clarifying their position as a "Welcoming, but Not-Affirming" congregation. Dr. Collins is a major thought leader and a much-sought speaker in church life, and his congregation (very similar to ours in our theological stance) is a thriving and dynamic presence in their city and beyond.

Dr. Collins has written a very insightful and instructive book entitled *What Does It Mean to Be Welcoming?* At the request of the Transition Team, FBC is purchasing 75 copies of "What Does It Mean to Be Welcoming?" as a gift to each requesting family at no cost. Due to limited quantities on Amazon, there may be a 2-week delay in getting all copies into the FBC office, so we will distribute beginning this Sunday on a "first-come, first-served" basis for those who have already signed-up. 
