Many Hands Make Light Work

The old adage holds true – a job that can be overwhelming when undertaken by too few becomes a cinch when everybody pitches in. Below are some of the places in the life of the church where we could use a few more hands. See if one might fit you!

Security Team: T.J. Fusco heads up our security team. Each Sunday, it is comprised of two two-men teams. One is stationed at the Fant Street entrance (back entrance)- sits at the welcome station and lets folks in the back door. The other is stationed on the Manning Street side to monitor folks entering the sanctuary. Depending on weather conditions, some will sit in their car and some stand on the front porch. In a nutshell, security monitors the only

unlocked doors to the church (all other access doors are locked.)

Currently, volunteers serve about six times a year. They all do a great job and have willingly taken on the responsibility, but it would make T. J. very happy not to have to call on them as frequently as he has recently.

If you would like to find out more about being a part of this vital ministry, please call the church office or, better yet, contact TJ personally (864-940-4702). It would be a big help!

Greeters: This is a similar need. TJ and Tulip Fusco, Emmie Hazle, and Terry Atkins are here every Sunday morning-faithfully holding the door, helping people up steps, handing out bulletins and greeting members and newcomers alike. They love doing it and they are good at it, but it would be helpful to have a few others to share the load and fill in when they have to be out.

So, if you like sprucing up a little, putting on a happy face and making people (especially guests) feel welcome and cared for, this may be just the spot for you! Again, contact Sharon in the church office or contact TJ personally.

Nursery Care for Preschoolers: We have paid nursery workers, but we always need a couple of additional volunteers each Sunday. The good news is that we are starting to have more preschoolers in regular attendance, so the need for volunteers has grown. If you would be willing to take one Sunday every couple of months, it would make the burden lighter for those who already serve. Elana Roach (864-940-4199) is a good contact if you have questions. Contact Sharon in the church office or Elana to add your name to the list.

I am so grateful for all those who give of their time and energy to make the church an inviting, safe and welcoming place for those who share the journey with us. It warms my heart to see people who give so generously of themselves. I am also excited about new folks and new opportunities that point to renewed growth and possibilities in the coming months.
