# **REFLECTIONS ON THIS YEAR'S DEACON ELECTION**

The past year has been one of major transition in the life of our church. One of the changes has been in the role of the deacon, especially in relation to efforts to organize the church to more effectively fulfill its purpose as defined in its purpose statement.

In the past thirty or more years, the primary defined role of the deacon has been to provide ministry to assigned families in the church. With changing circumstances, needs and demographics, a different approach to deacon ministry proved desirable. While the Deacon Family Ministry Plan is no longer in effect, we will be seeking to develop ministry approaches that meet the various needs of people in our congregation. The CARE team for Senior Adults (those who are homebound, in assisted living centers or with special needs) is the first step in this process.

The key shift in the role of the deacon has been a *re-emphasis* on the deacon as a "servant-leader", working in conjunction with pastoral staff to provide *leadership and support* to those who work in the various areas of church life (Worship, Spiritual Growth, Ministry, Fellowship, Missions, Outreach, as well as Administration).

As always, our congregation is seeking men and women who display spiritual maturity, faithful devotion, willing service, and a humble and cooperative spirit to fill this vital role. With the renewed emphasis on leadership, we also seek those with a passion and vision for the work of the church who can help guide our church into the future God has awaiting us.

### A REPORT FROM THE DEACON TEAM ASSIGNED TO THE ADMINISTRATION CLUSTER

As the role of the deacons has shifted from primarily the old Deacon Family Ministry plan, the first order of business this team wanted to focus on is making sure we have job descriptions for all officers and committees that fall under the Administration area of church life.

This will help to provide clarity, not only for those currently serving, but especially for new people that are recruited and assume responsibilities.
