

FROM THE INTERIM PASTOR

Before Thanksgiving slips too far into the background, with all the Advent and Christmas activity is in full gear, I want to take the opportunity to express my deepest appreciation for the surprise anniversary recognition in the November 23rd worship service. It was one of the most thoughtful (and stealthily executed) acts of kindness this old boy has encountered along this 50-year journey of ministry. I'm still not exactly sure how it was all carried out or the role each person played, but to the church as a whole and especially to those who came up with and executed "the plan," I thank you from the bottom of my heart.

The painting is beautifully done- by an artist that is a dear friend from Beaufort who has done family paintings of our kids and our granddaughter for us before. Miles, the child in the picture is the first-born of a wonderful Marine couple who became like family to us in a short time while serving in Beaufort. They were part of a young adult class we taught- one of the joys of our time there. Out of that class, there were weddings and baby dedications that were such happy times.

Marines move about, as do Pastors; but somehow we stayed connected with many of them. I was so honored when the Barrs asked me to come to Florida while they were on a furlough assignment from Okinawa to baptize the child I once held as a baby for his dedication. I am so grateful to them for making the long trek from Quantico to share this special moment with this church family which has blessed my life during the past year. Somehow it ties the years together... and boy, what a touching surprise!

I remember seeing the original photograph Becky took and thinking it was one of my favorite ever. I found it hard to express exactly the deep feeling that welled up in me when I looked at it. In some ways, it summed up my life as a minister. It is about relationships, about one generation making way for the next, about hope and new beginnings. But there was something more.

I looked up the word "ethereal." I think it comes close to what I feel when I look at that picture. "To be ethereal means to be extremely delicate, light and otherworldly... something that is heavenly, spiritual, or intangible." While the painting is tied to a meaningful personal event, it somehow speaks to me of heaven- of taking the hand of someone and helping them on a journey toward heaven.

I think the artist saw it too. She captured it so well. It has an ethereal quality.

Thank you for a wonderful gift. I will cherish the love I have found among you in these days together whenever I look at it.
